## Whyte wins inaugural East Cork '5'

THE inaugural East Cork Five-mile Road Championship was held over a four-lap course at Ballynow on a cold but sunny St Patrick's morning.

With East Cork's premier runner, Laim O'Brien, on international duty at the five-Mills classic in Italy, it was left to Midleton clubmate Pat Whyte to take the individual honours. Whyte, who had just completed a very successful cross-country season, came home an easy winner in a time of 25.18—almost a minute ahead of teammate Albert de Doban, with another Midleton athlete John Walshe in third position.

Gerry Wallis had a brilliant run to take the under-16 prize in fourth place overall with a time of 27.10. There was an exciting tussle for the first junior prize between local athlete Denis McCarthy and Seamus Hartnett, with McCarthy getting the verdict by just three seconds. John Hartnett, better known as a decathlete, won the novice prize in 28.47 while his sister, Bridie, took the ladies award in a time of 32.09.
